

PATHWAYS TO THE SKILLED TRADES INDUSTRIAL TRADES

This **FREE** 8-week program targets individuals who are currently unemployed, interested in exploring the trades & may be experiencing financial hardship.

The program includes **30 hours of paid training per week including**:

- 15 hours of Trades Exposure (Electrical Control, Machining, Welding)
- 6 hours of Academic Upgrading,
- 2 hours of Employment Prep

You will have access to safety training and certifications like First Aid & Working at Heights. Moreover, you will also participate in possible facility tours and participate in workshops such as Apprenticeships, Emotional Intelligence, Pathways, Funding Your Education, Time Management, etc.

You will also receive **one-on-one employment assistance** from our Skilled Trades Advisor.

PROGRAM DURATION: 8 weeks followed by a

12-week paid placement

ELIGIBILITY: Ages 18-30 & Currently Unemployed

PROGRAM SUPPORTS: Participants will earn minimum wage to attend classes (30 hrs/week).

Additionally, they will earn a bonus for program completion & work completion.

Assistance is also provided to cover transportation, food & emergency costs, if required.
